## **1. Basic information**

30 June 2024 - applications for fall/winter semester or entire academic year  
15 December 2024 - applications for spring/summer semester

## **2. Requirements**

### **2.1 Nomination**

All students must be nominated by Erasmus+ coordinator from their sending institution by e-mail (e-mails: [krzbikon@pg.edu.pl](mailto:krzbikon@pg.edu.pl) and [erasmus@pg.edu.pl](mailto:erasmus@pg.edu.pl))

### **2.2 On-line registration**

Students applying for exchange must fill out *application form* using on-line registration system: [moja.pg.edu.pl](http://moja.pg.edu.pl) >> Applications >> Erasmus

### **2.3 Documents**

The following documents are required:

- learning agreement for studies (online learning agreement - <https://learning-agreement.eu/>) signed by Student and Erasmus coordinator at sending institution,
- transcript of records,
- a copy of certificate confirming fluency in English at B1 level (certificates issued by Language Centre at universities are accepted)

3.3 In case of courses in Polish, teachers can switch to English when exchange students arrive or they can facilitate studying and assessment in mode of individual tuition in English. Before a course is placed in Learning Agreement, ask the subject supervisor for the course (information on the course card) about the possibility of participating in such a course. We recommend limiting the number of selected courses in Polish to the minimum necessary and choosing courses in English.
