

RULES OF THE BY BIKE TO THE UNIVERSITY COMPETITION

§1 PURPOSE AND GENERAL ASSUMPTIONS

1. The non-public sports competition "By bike to the University" (hereinafter: the "Competition") is carried out using the <https://rowery.pg.edu.pl/> website. The aim of the campaign is to promote the UN Sustainable Development Goals (in particular Goal No. 3: Good Health and Well-Being, Goal No. 11: Sustainable Cities and Communities, and Goal No. 13: Climate Action) among students, doctoral students and employees of Gdańsk University of Technology by encouraging the use of sustainable means of transport such as bicycles, scooters and personal transport devices (UTOs) in their daily commuting to the university, and by raising awareness of the impact of transport on the environment.
2. The Competition is organised by Gdańsk University of Technology, hereinafter referred to as the Organiser.
3. The competition starts on 13.04.2026 and ends on 30.09.2026.
4. The Organizer has the exclusive right to make decisions in matters not regulated by these Regulations and the right to interpret the provisions of the Regulations.

§2 JOINING THE COMPETITION

1. The Contest is intended only for persons who are students, doctoral students or employees of the Organizer, hereinafter referred to as the "Participant".
2. Participation in the Competition is voluntary and free of charge.
3. The Participant enters the Competition by registering on the Competition website indicated by the Organizer and creating a profile, from 01.04.2026 until the end of the Competition.
4. To enter the Competition, the Participant:
 - 1) register via the registration form available at: <https://rowery.pg.edu.pl/>,
 - 2) reads and accepts the Rules of the by bike to the university competition,
 - 3) agrees to the processing of personal data,
 - 4) acts in accordance with the Regulations and recommendations presented by the Organizer.
5. In order to create a profile, the Participant is obliged to register by providing:
 - 1) place of residence (town/district),
 - 2) selected means of transport: bicycle, electric bicycle, scooter, electric scooter, UTO,
 - 3) the distance in kilometers between the place of residence and the University, which the participant travels by the selected means of transport (indicated in point 2). In the case of combining means of transport, the participant does not include the kilometres travelled by public transport/car in this distance. In case of a change of residence, changes must be made to the system.
 - 4) nickname.

6. The Organizer reserves the right to remove the nickname introduced by the participant, referred to in §2 section 5 point 4 and replace it with the participant's name if it is offensive or contains vulgarisms.
7. One Participant may have only one profile under which he will be entitled to participate in the Competition.
8. Participants of previous editions of the "Bike to University" Competition are not required to create a profile and register as specified in §2 sections 3-5.

§3 TEAM REGISTRATION

1. Participants who entered the competition individually can form a team of 4 people.
2. A team can consist of 4 students/PhD students or 4 Gdańsk Tech employees.
3. In order to create a team, you need to:
 - 1) appoint a team leader who will be responsible for its registration on the competition website and designate the other 3 participants,
 - 2) give the team a unique name.
4. The team's score is the sum of all rides registered by its members during the competition.
5. Team members take part in individual and team competition at the same time.
6. The team must be formed between 01.04.2026 and 30.04.2026.
7. The Organizer reserves the right to change the name introduced by the team, referred to in paragraph 3 point 2, if it is offensive or contains vulgarisms.
8. The composition of the team cannot be changed during the Competition.
9. A participant can only belong to one team.

§4 DATA ENTRY

1. A participant who commutes to / from the University by bike, scooter or personal transport device records their ride on the Competition website.
2. Only the following commutes are registered in the competition:
 - 1) bike (including electric bike), scooter (including electric scooter), or personal transport device
 - 2) from your place of residence to the University and from the University to your place of residence or journeys that are part of this route
3. The participant's place of work or study is considered to be Gdańsk University of Technology with its registered office at 11/12 G. Narutowicza Street in Gdańsk, regardless of the place of employment and actual performance of official duties.
4. The place of residence is considered to be the city/district indicated by the participant in the profile referred to in § 2 section 5 point 1 of the Regulations.
5. A participant can make a maximum of two rides per day, for a total of no more than 10 rides per week. A week is assumed to be 7 consecutive calendar days, from Monday to Sunday.
6. When registering the ride , the participant only provides the date of the ride by bike, scooter or personal transport device. The default distance for each trip is the value declared in the registration form as the distance from your place of residence to the University.
7. Information on how to get to/from the University can be entered no later than two days from the day

of travel.

8. Recreational travel data cannot be entered on the competition website.

9. The competition website will show:

1) Ranking of 10 participants in the categories: employees and students/doctoral students with the highest number of rides.

2) team ranking, including the top 5 teams according to the total number of rides of all team members in the categories: employees and students/doctoral students.

§5 INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

1. Each participant joining the Competition has the right to receive prizes depending on the number of trips to / from the University during the competition:

1) for 70 commutes in total – the promotional item from the Organizer with a value of up to 20 PLN;

2) for 120 commutes in total – the promotional item from the Organizer with a value of up to 45 PLN;

2. The prizes listed in §5 sections 1-2 will be awarded in accordance with the following rule: prizes under §5 point 1 will be awarded to 150 participants who will be the first to complete a total of 70 rides, while prizes under §5 point 2 will be awarded to 70 participants who will be the first to complete 120 rides.

3. The main prizes will be awarded during the Competition Final to the participants in the following categories: employees and students/doctoral students who will complete the most commuting to/from work during the competition:

1) 1st place – a shopping voucher worth PLN 500,

2) 2nd place – a shopping voucher worth PLN 300,

3) 3rd place – a shopping voucher worth PLN 200.

4. The teams that take the first and second place in the team classification in the following categories: employees and students/PhD students in terms of the highest number of rides will receive a voucher for a dinner at the Hydrostacja restaurant worth PLN 200.

5. Among the Participants who register at least 70 rides, during the Competition, a draw for additional prizes will be held, other than those listed in §5 section 1 and 3. Prizes will only be awarded to Participants present at the final of the Competition.

6. The Competition Final will take place after the end of the Competition, at a place and time planned by the Organizer.

7. The winners of the Contest will be notified of their win by e-mail within a maximum of 5 working days from the end of the contest.

8. The winners of the competition have no right to transfer the right to the prize to third parties.

9. The Organizer allows for the possibility of giving participants prizes from sponsors:

1) sponsor promotional items;

2) other prizes as determined by the sponsor and the Organizer;

10. The prizes specified in §5 sec. 3 will constitute revenue and will be taxed on appropriate terms. Before collecting the prizes described in §5 section 3, students and doctoral students will be obliged to pay 10% of the prize value as tax on the prize to the account of Gdańsk University of Technology provided by the Organiser.

§6 FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The Organizer will verify the data, and in the event that they do not comply with these regulations, the Organizer reserves the right to disqualify the Participant from the Competition.
2. In the event of disqualification of a participant from the Competition, he or she will be informed by email. The Participant has the right to appeal against the decision on the possible disqualification of the Participant from the Competition, in accordance with §6 section 3.
3. An appeal in connection with the Competition should be reported to the Organizer in the form of an e-mail to the following address: rowery@pg.edu.pl together with a description of the situation and detailed justification, within a period of no more than 7 days from the date of occurrence of the grounds for appeal. The appeal is resolved by the Organizer. The participant has the right to appeal to the Rector against the Organiser's decision within 7 days from the date of its receipt.
4. Appeals will be considered by the Organizer no later than 10 days from the date of their receipt.
5. The Competition is not a game of chance (including a promotional lottery) or a pari-mutuel bet within the meaning of the Gambling Act of 19 November 2009.
6. Subject to the following paragraphs, the Organiser may amend the Terms and Conditions only for important reasons, such as:
 - 1) a change in the law having a direct impact on the content of the Terms and Conditions;
 - 2) imposition of certain obligations on the Organiser by public authorities and having a direct impact on the content of the Regulations,
 - 3) change of data concerning the Organizer;
 - 4) counteracting abuses consisting in circumventing the provisions of the Regulations in order to undue advantage.
 - 5) improving the operation of the Competition and the service of participants;
 - 6) Improve the privacy of participants.
7. A change in the Regulations may not limit or diminish the rights previously acquired by the Participants in connection with participation in the Competition.
8. The Organizer notifies the Participants of any changes to the Regulations by sending an e-mail to the Participants. Information about changes in the Regulations is also posted on the Competition website each time.
